

## **Creation Commandment 8: Grow and Adapt**

Genesis 1:22 "God blessed them, saying, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth."

Here in the 8<sup>th</sup> command of creation God blesses them. It's the first time He did that. Yes, God said his creation was good, but this is the first mention of a blessing. He also asks them to go forth and multiply for the first time. This is setting up the next command. Creatures of blood will be blessed by God. He will also ask them to be self-sufficient for the first time. God created but now his living creatures are asked to create.

Ok, to be fair, the statement above is not totally true. God made seed bearing plants. I'm betting all the cycles of the environment are working. Steam goes up and condensation comes down. Simba would be in heaven seeing the circle of life working. In general, I base each command on the word "let." In the Bible are hints of Gods direction. He creates and then He sets it in motion. That is how God rolls. Somehow and someway God chose to make something first and then let it fly so to speak. This 8<sup>th</sup> command of creation is that in motion.

We have to see the plan. God is literally setting up this planet for humans, not only survive, but thrive. Molecules, protons, neutrons and such divide and grow. Plants produce seeds and multiply. The flavor of God's creation is separate (divide) and grow. Yet, with blood creatures it's slightly different. They are to come together and create another copy. As with plants,

So, where do we go from here? God is not done creating. A human soul needs direction, trials, and teaching. It needs to feel alone in the world. Why? God said that man will have dominion over all creation on the earth. He is to subdue it and take care of it. God created but now we will. It's like someone building a computer program and teaching the user the ropes. To use a program, you must know how to turn it on. We must know how to use it to make something better. From spread sheets to computer programing, we are to go forth and multiply. As we shall see in the last two parts of creation, we are to take what God built and go forward. He is finished creating the planet but he's not done enacting his plan and will.
