The controversy will rage on. The name Jesus has started wars, killed people, and made people enemies. Jesus said in the Bible that he will cause division and that has certainly

happened. Can you think of one name that has caused so much trouble? Can you think of one name that is fictional and controversial enough to kill? What happens if the person of Jesus is real? C.S. Lewis wrote "A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. The discussion on Jesus is always hotly debated, but why? Isn't he mythical, fictional, or just a man?
